

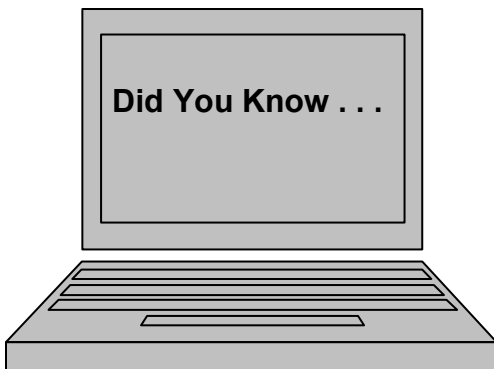


KEEPING KIDS SAFE IN THE DIGITAL WORLD
